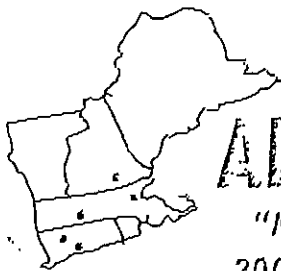

This semi-annual inspection / maintenance may also be a requirement, as applicable, of your insurance company, your landlord's insurance co., the MA liquor control commission, your fire marshal, building official and/or health department. Certainly, it is a requirement of the manufacturer of your system to maintain any warranty you might have.

\*NFPA 17A, which requires wet chemical fire suppression systems to be inspected every six months. "7.3.1" A trained person who has undergone the instructions necessary to perform the maintenance and recharge service reliably and has the applicable manufacturer's listed installation and maintenance manual and service bulletins shall service the wet chemical fire-extinguishing system 6 months apart as outlined in 7.3.2.
