## Dear Ann:

The following are the buildings on Union Wharf outside of the NUMOZ area, the associated square footages and what business is located on the first floor in these buildings:

1. #36 Union Wharf - 5,000 sf - 100 % marine use on the 1st floor - Brown Ship Services (ship supply and service), Custom Float Services (dock construction and service), Sawyer & Whitten Marine Electronics and Maine Life Raft and Inflatable Co..

- \*2. #38 Union Wharf 1,456 sf marine tenant leaving. Vacant on 9/14/15.
- 3. #41 Union Wharf 1,750 sf 100 % marine use on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor Lucky Catch Lobster(lobster tanks) and CBS Lobster (lobster tanks and servicing of lobster boats – bait etc).
- 4. #48 Union Wharf 6,000 sf 100% marine use on the 1st floor Portland Pilots offices and small warehouse for boat equipment (bring large ships into port), Maine Lobster Direct – offices -lobster tanks, freezers, coolers, ship lobster around the world, Proprietors of Union Wharf operators of Union Wharf - storage of equipment.

- -5. #50 Union Wharf 1,536 sf 100 % marine Maine Lobster Direct lobster tanks.
- -6. #52 Union Wharf -2,388 sf 100% marine CBS Lobster 288 sf office and 2100 sf lobster bait cooler. Service lobster boats – bait and buying lobsters.
  - 7. #55 Union Wharf 240 sf 100 % marine MSRC utility room for water and power and storage to serve the Maine responder oil spill cleanup vessel.
- -8. #35 Union Wharf -5,100 sf 100% marine on 1<sup>st</sup> floor-Cozy Harbor Seafood lobster tanks, storage of lobsters.
- -9. #28 Union Wharf 1,800 sf 100% marine CBS Lobster pallets of salt and equipment.
- 10. #14 Union Wharf 12,000 sf 100% marine Marine Spill Response Corp oil spill cleanup equipment and offices.
  - 11. All dockage and open spaces are tied up with the buildings listed above and are 100% marine use. Parking is reserved for all building tenants on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floors. All fishing vessels have a reserved parking area.
