Dear Mr. Palacci:

An evaluation of the property at 47 Exchange St. revealed that the property fails to comply with Article 9, Section 14-634 of the Historical Preservation Code, of the City of Portland. .

This is a **STOP WORK ORDER** pursuant to Section 117.1 of the 1999 BOCA Building Code. All construction activity at the above referenced property must **STOP** immediately.

Construction may begin after the amendment to your building permit application has been issued and this order has been lifted.

Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. Ss 4452. This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 1-16.(2) of the City of Portland Code of Ordinances.
