#### **Conditions:**

- 1) The exhaust termination shall be a minimum 10 feet horizontally from property lines.
- 2) Hood suppression system shall comply with NFPA 17A, 96, and UL 300. Activation of the suppression system shall activate the fire alarm system if available. A letter of compliance will be required at the time of final inspection stating: the date the system was tested for operation, fuel gas shut off, and fire alarm connection if applicable. The Class K fire extinguisher and proper signage should be located at the suppression system pull station.
- 3) A separate Non-Water Based Suppression System permit is required. This review does not include approval of the suppression system design or installation.
- 4) Any cutting and welding done will require a Hot Work Permit from Fire Department.
- 5) Installation shall comply with City Code Chapter 10 and NFPA 96, Standard for ventilation Control and Fire Protection of Commercial Cooking Operations, 2008 edition. A signed letter of certification is required.

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
