APARTMENT 2A:

1. Extension cords throughout the apartment. Install additional outlets to eliminate cords. ART: 90-1 & 110-3(a)(5) & 400-8

THIRD FLOOR:

ELECTRICAL CLOSET:

1. This closet must be kept clean and maintained as such, at all times. This is a fire hazard. ART: 110-16(b)

These violations and unsafe conditions shall be abated/corrected within 30 days upon receipt of this letter. Failure to comply shall result in further legal action from this office.
