The Property is located within the B-3 Downtown Business Zone with a Pedestrian Activities District (PAD) Overlay Zone along Spring Street Arterial and Middle Street which limits first floor uses in the Ordinance. To the best of my knowledge, the Property is in compliance with applicable zoning codes, regulations and related ordinances. The Property is currently vacant and has no building permits or certificates of occupancy on file.
