A recent inspection conducted on or about June 23, 1999, revealed the following electrical violations and unsafe conditions, which shall be corrected, pursuant to NEC 1996 and all applicable electrical codes.

### **APARTMENT #402:**

---No violations found.

# **APARTMENT #401:**

---Extension cord passing through a wall under the stairs.

# APARTMENT #404:

- ---Cover plate missing.
- ---Recessed light trim missing in bathroom.
- ---Add GFCI protection in the bathroom.

# **STORAGE AREA 4th FLOOR:**

---Remove ZIP cord and illegal fixtures. Install approved lighting in this area.

# **APARTMENT #405:**

- ---Loose range receptacle.
- ---Cover plates missing.
- ---Loose ceiling fixture.

# **APARTMENT #407:**

- ---Repair or replace noisy bath exhaust fan.
- ---Properly adjust electrical panel interior.

# **APARTMENT #408:**

---Loose receptacle at kitchen counter.

#### **APARTMENT #406:**

---Bathroom GFCI receptacle is not working properly.

#### **APARTMENT #409:**

---No entry

### **APARTMENT #410:**

- ---Smoke detector missing.
- ---Remove extension cords. Add receptacles as needed.
- ---Install GFCI protection in the bathroom.
- ---Replace broken wall switch.

#### **APARTMENT #412:**

- ---Loose circuit breaker in electrical panel.
- ---Remove extension cords. Add receptacles as needed.

#### **APARTMENT #414:**

- ---Vacant, no power.
- ---Loose Armored Cables, type AC near entry to apartment.
- ---Provide GFCI protection at kitchen counter.

### **APARTMENT #413:**

- ---Smoke detector missing.
- ---Provide GFCI protection at the kitchen counter.

### APARTMENT #411:

---No entry.

### **APARTMENT #311:**

---Provide GFCI protection at the kitchen counter.

# **APARTMENT #306:**

---Provide GFCI protection at the kitchen counter.

# **APARTMENT #313:**

- ---Missing receptacle plate in the kitchen.
- ---Re-secure the EMT conduit, which feeds the smoke detector.
- ---Install a new lens for the bathroom shower fixture.

# **APARTMENT #312:**

- ---Smoke detector missing.
- ---Label electrical panel.
- ---Provide GFCI protection for the bathroom and at the kitchen counter.
- ---Fixture missing on the ceiling in the kitchen area.

# **APARTMENT #314:**

- ---Provide GFCI protection at the kitchen counter.
- ---Bathroom receptacle is loose.
- ---Label panel.

### **APARTMENT #310:**

- ---Loose, exposed wiring at water heater.
- ---Missing wall plates.

### **APARTMENT #309:**

---No entry.

### **APARTMENT #308:**

---No entry.

#### **APARTMENT #307:**

- ---Blank off or provide GFCI protection for bathroom receptacle.
- ---Loose wall receptacle.
- ---Re-secure range receptacle.
- ---Label electrical panel.

#### **APARTMENT #305:**

- ---Relocate receptacles over the range.
- ---Repair or replace bathroom GFCI receptacle.
- ---Missing smoke detector.

### **APARTMENT #303:**

- ---Provide GFCI protection at the kitchen counter.
- ---Label electrical panel.

### **APARTMENT #304:**

---No entry.

### **APARTMENT #301:**

- ---Missing wall plates.
- ---Label electrical panel.

# **APARTMENT #302:**

---No entry.

These electrical violations and unsafe conditions shall be corrected no later than August 13, 1999. Failure to comply shall result in further legal action to be taken by this office.
