Reduced plans or electronic files in PDF format are required. Per State Fire Marshall, all new bathrooms must be ADA compliant.

For additions less than 500 sq. ft. or that does not affect parking or traffic, a site plan exemption should be filed including:
 The shape and dimension of the lot, footprint of the existing and proposed structure and the distance from the actual property lines.
