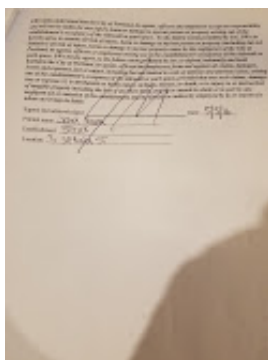
To the Department of Permitting and Inspections.

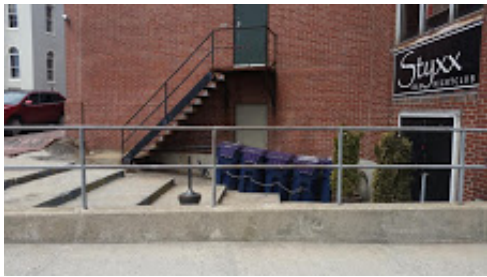

Hi Josh

We're all the same department. You will need a building permit for the new deck area prior to this outside dining permit being issued (because it's dependent on the construction.) Also, reviewing your outside dining application in more depth, you didn't provide the actual seating area dimensions OR the number of planned tables and chairs. This information is required for a complete (outdoor dining) application. It will be entered, but it will not be issued without 1. The Patio building permit issued and 2. The dimensions and table and chair info. You will receive an invoice, and can pay for it, if you wish.

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
