Hi Deanna,

I'm in the process of reviewing the three sign applications that you recently inquired about. I have already approved the permit for 2 Canal Plaza and you should be seeing that in your e-mail shortly. However, I had questions on the other two permits.

For 6 City Center, could you provide the amount of building frontage that is allotted to each of the two ground floor tenants? The total street frontage is 43' and it looks like it is roughly divided in half between the two tenants, but I need confirmation on that.

Yes, the frontage of the building is split between the two tenants.... 21.5 feet for each.

For 1 Monument Square, could you provide the building frontage figures for the three sides where the signs will be attached, and also the building height? As stated in the application checklist, the sketch plan is supposed to include the distance each sign will be from the ground and the building facade dimensions. Under the ordinance, the size of each sign is limited to 5% of the total square footage the facade it will be attached to.

Building height = 138 feet

Federal Street building length = 100 ft

Congress Street building length = 100 ft

Monument Square building length = 110 ft
