RE: Grease Trap Waiver /161 Commercial St.

This office has reviewed your request dated January 13, 2004, a waiver from Grease Interceptor provisions for Food Service Establishments in the Maine State Plumbing Code

The following are the facts:

- 1) The operation will be simulating a "home cooking" environment for up to 15 students, 3 evening per week.
- 2) There will be "drop by" cooking demonstrations on Saturdays.
- 3) Portions will be limited to sample sized portions.

Based on the above facts the City of Portland hereby grants the request based on the following conditions:

- 1) Program modifications that result in an increase in grease-laden waste generated at the establishment will result in the requirement of the installation of a grease interceptor.

With regard to the "Viking" dishwasher, the product must bear the NSF seal and provide a cumulative wash/rinse temperature that will cause a "thermolabel" (temperature sensitive tape) to react (turn black) during a regular cycle.
