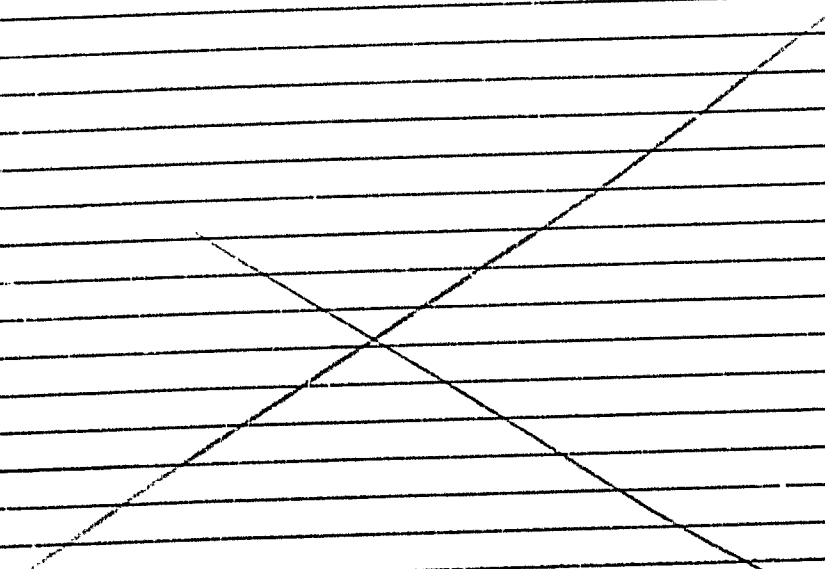


We recently received a complaint and an inspection was made by Code Enforcement Officer Burton MacIsaac of the property owned by you at 49 Hanover Street, Portland, Maine. As a result of the inspection, you are hereby ordered to correct the following substandard housing conditions:

1. FRONT CHIMNEY ABOVE ROOF - missing bricks and mortar. 6-108
2. OVERALL EXTERIOR - walls - missing siding. 6-108
3. RIGHT ROOF - broken drain. 6-108
4. RIGHT ROOF - rotted eave. 6-108
5. LEFT EXTERIOR - foundation - missing mortar. 6-108
6. RIGHT PORCH - steps - broken and rotted. 6-108

The above mentioned conditions are in violation of Article V of the Municipal Code of the City of Portland, Maine, and must be corrected on or before June 9, 1987

Failure to comply with this order may result in a complaint being filed for prosecution in District Court.
