


- I. ONSITE TOPOGRAPHIC AND PROPERTY BOUNDARY INFORMATION TAKEN FROM THE FOLLOWING:
- I.I. A PLAN TITLED "PARTIAL BOUNDARY SURVEY OF THE SALVATION ARMY", PREPARED BY JONES ASSOCIATES, INC. OF AUBURN, MAINE, DATED JULY 6, 2016.
- I.2. FIELD OBSERVATIONS BY WALSH ENGINEERING ASSOCIATES, INC. ON MULTIPLE SITE VISITS IN 2015 AND 2016.
- 2. PLAN IS REFERENCED TO CITY OF PORTLAND HORIZONTAL DATUM, MAINE STATE PLANE COORDINATE SYSTEM, WEST ZONE, NAD83.
- 3. BASIS OF PROPERTY LINE BEARINGS IS CITY OF PORTLAND HORIZONTAL DATUM, MAINE STATE
- PLANE COORDINATE SYSTEM, WEST ZONE, NAD83.
- 4. ELEVATIONS SHOWN ARE TIED TO THE CITY OF PORTLAND DATUM (NGVD29) PER CITY OF PORTLAND OFFSET MONUMENT MF I 42 AT THE SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF ALDER STREET AND KENNEBEC STREET, DRILL HOLE ELEVATION 10.145.
- 5. TO OUR KNOWLEDGE, PHASE I AND PHASE II ENVIRONMENTAL SITE ASSESSMENTS HAVE NOT BEEN CONDUCTED AT THIS SITE. THEREFORE, SUBSURFACE CONDITIONS ARE UNKNOWN.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING "DIG SAFE" AND LOCAL UTILITY COMPANIES AT LEAST THREE (3) BUSINESS DAYS, BUT NOT MORE THAN 30 CALENDAR DAYS, PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF ANY EXCAVATION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH MAINE STATE LAW. "DIG SAFE" TELEPHONE NUMBER IS 1-888-344-7233.


- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY AND ALL MEANS, METHODS, AND TECHNIQUES EMPLOYED TO PERFORM THE WORK SHOWN ON THE
- 3. ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING UTILITIES AND/OR SITE FEATURES AS A RESULT OF CONTRACTOR ACTIVITIES SHALL BE REPAIRED TO THE CONDITION IMMEDIATELY BEFORE DAMAGE OCCURRED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.
- 4. ALL WORK SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS INCLUDING ALL SAFETY REGULATIONS (OSHA).
- ALL WORK SHALL BE IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE CITY OF PORTLAND REQUIREMENTS.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SECURE ALL NECESSARY PERMITS FOR THE WORK SHOWN ON THESE PLANS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.
- ALL EROSION CONTROL MEASURES SHALL BE INSTALLED PRIOR TO ANY SITE EXCAVATION OR REGRADING.
- CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY ALL EXISTING CONDITIONS SHOWN ON THE DRAWINGS. IF ANY DISCREPANCIES ARE FOUND, THE OWNER OR OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE SHALL BE
- THE SUBJECT PROPERTY IS NOT LOCATED WITHIN THE 100-YEAR FLOOD PLAIN AS DEPICTED ON THE FEMA FLOOD INSURANCE RATE MAPS.
- 10. ALL WATER MAIN AND WATER SERVICE WORK SHALL COMPLY WITH PORTLAND WATER DISTRICT REQUIREMENTS. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING ALL REQUIRED PERMITS FROM THE PORTLAND WATER DISTRICT.
- II. ALL PROPOSED WORK WITHIN THE ALDER STREET AND LANCASTER RIGHT-OF-WAYS SHALL MEET THE CITY OF PORTLAND TECHNICAL MANUAL STANDARDS.
- 12. INSTALL CATCH BASIN INLET PROTECTION IN DOWNGRADIENT CATCH BASINS IN ALL DIRECTIONS PRIOR TO EXCAVATION IN STREET
- 13. CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT A TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLAN TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR APPROVAL PRIOR TO ANY STREET AND/OR SIDEWALK CLOSURES.
- 14. ALL STREET CLOSURES SHALL BE PERFORMED DURING OFF-PEAK HOURS OR DURING THE NIGHT.
- 15. EXCAVATED SOIL IS ASSUMED TO BE "SPECIAL WASTE" AND SHALL BE CHARACTERIZED BY THE CONTRACTOR PRIOR TO OFFSITE DISPOSAL.
