An evaluation of your dwelling unit at 259 Oxford Street on June 12, 2000 revealed that the unit fails to comply with Section 6-120.1 of The Housing Code of the City of Portland.

The violations are as follows:

120.1 - Apt D-2 3rd floor left front - Unsanitary conditions, human feces on floor and bed, excessive trash through out unit, rotting food

Based on that list, and pursuant to Section 6-120.(1), this office declares the dwelling unit is unfit for human habitation. A reinspection of the premises will occur on June 14, 2000 at which time the dwelling unit must be totally vacated and secured from vandalism. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code. This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 6-127 of the Code. Please feel free to contact me at 874-8706, if you wish to discuss the matter or have any questions.
