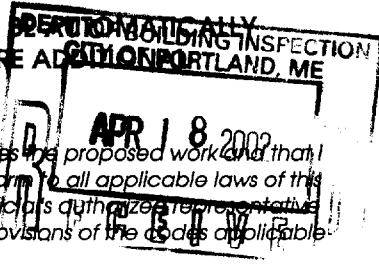

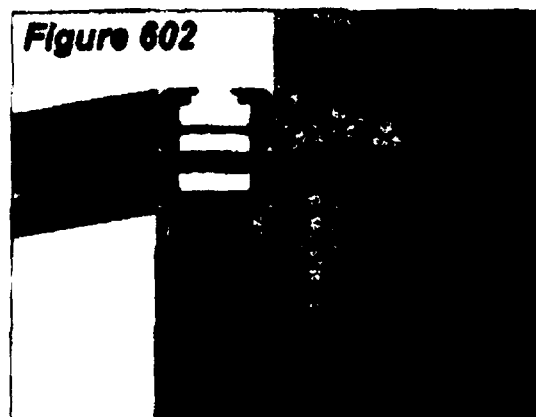

Connection Types

Z-Bracket Connections & Direct Connections

There are two types of connections used to attach awning and canopy frames to buildings and other structures. One type is the z-bracket connection, which consists of the bracket, a wall connection fastener, and a frame connection fastener as shown in **Figure 601**. The second type of connection is the direct connection, which consists of a single fastener placed through a pre-drilled hole in the frame as shown in **Figure 602**. Both of these connection types can be made with any of the fasteners described in the previous section.

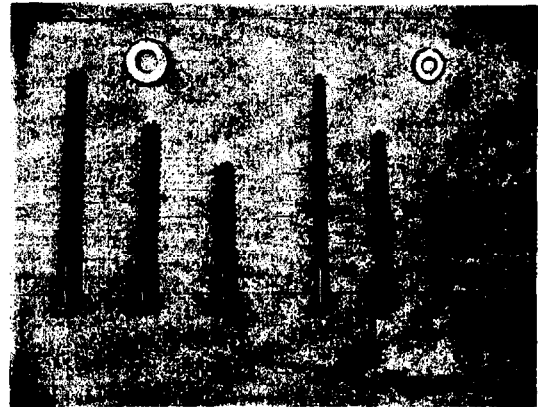
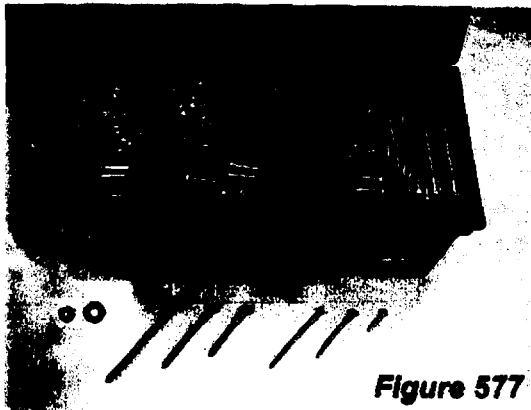


The *direct connection* is the best type of connection because it provides substantially greater strength at a comparable cost. All the connections shown in the *Fasteners* section, starting on page 397, are direct connections. The *z-bracket connection* should be made only when there is no way to make a direct connection. The z-bracket connection is most often found at the upper wall connections of awnings with large drop-to-projection ratios, where tool clearance is sometimes a problem. Despite their lower strength, z-bracket connections rarely create structural problems because large drop-to-projection ratios typically result in smaller connection point loads. Z-bracket connections do a good job of resisting vertical loads that act parallel to the wall plane, which occur more frequently in awnings with large drop-to-projection ratios. Oppositely, they do a poor job of resisting horizontal loads that act perpendicular to the wall plane and are commonly associated with small drop-to-projection ratios. This works out nicely because when a frame has an excessively small drop-to-projection ratio, there is most often adequate tool clearance to make a direct connection, which resists both types of loads well. Also, when the drop-to-projection ratio is small, columns are often added along the front edge of the awning (making it a canopy). This changes the loads at the upper wall connection, making them act parallel to the wall. This also means that z-bracket connections can be used on some short span canopies, even when there is adequate tool clearance for a direct connection.

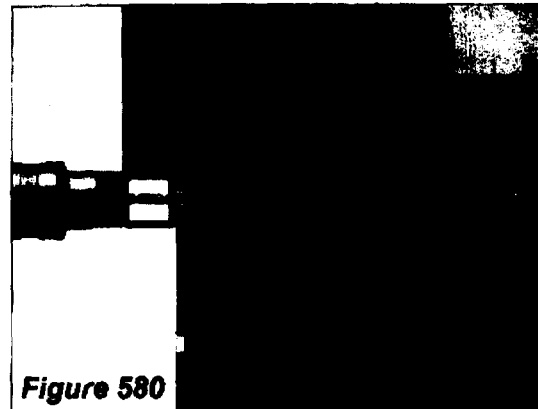
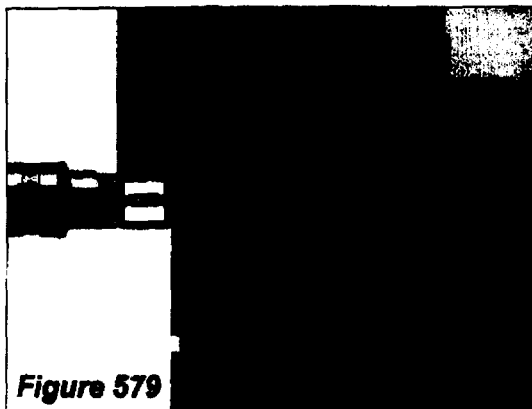
All lower awning and canopy wall connections should be *direct connections*. All upper awning and canopy wall connections should be *direct connections* when the rafter angle (see page 95) is less than 18°, as shown in **Figure 603**. When the rafter angle is greater than 18°, it becomes nearly impossible to drive the fasteners through the frame and into the wall because there is insufficient space for the drill motor to operate; therefore, all upper awning and canopy wall connections for rafter angles greater than 18° should be z-bracket connections as shown in **Figure 604**. All z-bracket connections require the frame to be attached to the z-bracket with a metal screw as shown. This is extremely important, and is the only thing holding the frame to the bracket, and therefore, to the wall. For installations with all direct connections, the z-bracket is used only as an installation tool to temporarily hold the frame while the direct connections are made.

Fastener Category #2 - Wood Lags

Wood lags are used when an awning or canopy frame must be connected to structural wood components such as wall studs, beams, and columns. A wood lag fastener box like the one shown in **Figure 577** should be kept in the installation vehicle. As a minimum, the following wood lags and hardware (shown in **Figure 578**) should be included: 1/4" x 3 1/2" wood lags, 1/4" x 4 1/2" wood lags, 1/4" x 6" wood lags, 3/8" x 3 1/2" wood lags, 3/8" x 4 1/2" wood lags, 3/8" x 6" wood lags, 5/16" i/d. x 3/4" o/d. x 1/16" flat washers, and 13/32" i/d. x 13/16" o/d. x 1/16" flat washers.



Before wood lags can be installed, there must be 1/4" pre-drilled holes through the awning or canopy frame. This should always be done while the frame is on the ground. If there are any non-wood materials between the frame and the wooden structural member, they must be pre-drilled as shown in **Figure 579**. Notice the drill bit stops before the wooden structural member. This pre-drilled hole should be at least 1/4" diameter for 1/4" wood lags and at least 3/8" diameter for 3/8" wood lags. Also, a pilot hole must be made into the wooden structural member to prevent the wood lag from splitting the wood and weakening the member, as shown in **Figure 580**. To drill the pilot hole, use a 3/16" bit for 1/4" wood lags and a 1/4" bit for 3/8" wood lags. Use the heavier 1/2" drill motor to drive the wood lags into the structure as shown in **Figure 581**. Driving wood lags with a standard 3/8" drill motor will burn up the motor. Use a 7/16" hex-drive for 1/4" lags and a 9/16" hex-drive for 3/8" lags. The 9/16" hex-drives are difficult to find, so you may have to create one by using a 9/16" socket and a 3/8" socket-to-drill motor adapter. A typical finished wood lag connection is shown in **Figure 582**. Select a wood lag that embeds at least 1" of threaded length into the wooden structural member.



Care and Cleaning

Sunbrella fabric should be cleaned regularly before substances such as dirt, roof particles, etc. are allowed to accumulate on and become imbedded in the fabric. The fabric can be cleaned without being removed from the frame. Simply brush off any loose dirt, roof particles, etc.; hose down and clean with a mild natural soap in lukewarm water (no more than 100 degrees Fahrenheit.) Rinse thoroughly to remove soap. **DO NOT USE DETERGENTS.** Allow to air dry.

For more stubborn cases: Soak the fabric for approximately twenty minutes in a solution of no more than 1/2 cup (4 oz.) of bleach and 1/4 cup (2 oz.) of natural soap per gallon of water at 100 degrees Fahrenheit. Rinse thoroughly in cold water to remove all of the soap. Note: Excessive soaking in bleach can deteriorate sewing threads. This method of cleaning may remove part of the water repellency and the fabric should receive an application of an air-curing water repellent treatment, such as 303 High Tech Fabric Guard, if water repellency is a factor.

Sunbrella may be dry cleaned but a water repellent treatment must be applied to the fabric after dry cleaning to reestablish water repellency. *Sunbrella* is made from 100% acrylic fiber and is thermoplastic or heat sensitive. When washing or cleaning, **DO NOT SUBJECT TO EXCESSIVE HEAT** as the fabric will shrink. **DO NOT STEAM PRESS OR DRY IN ELECTRIC OR GAS DRYERS**, but allow to air dry.

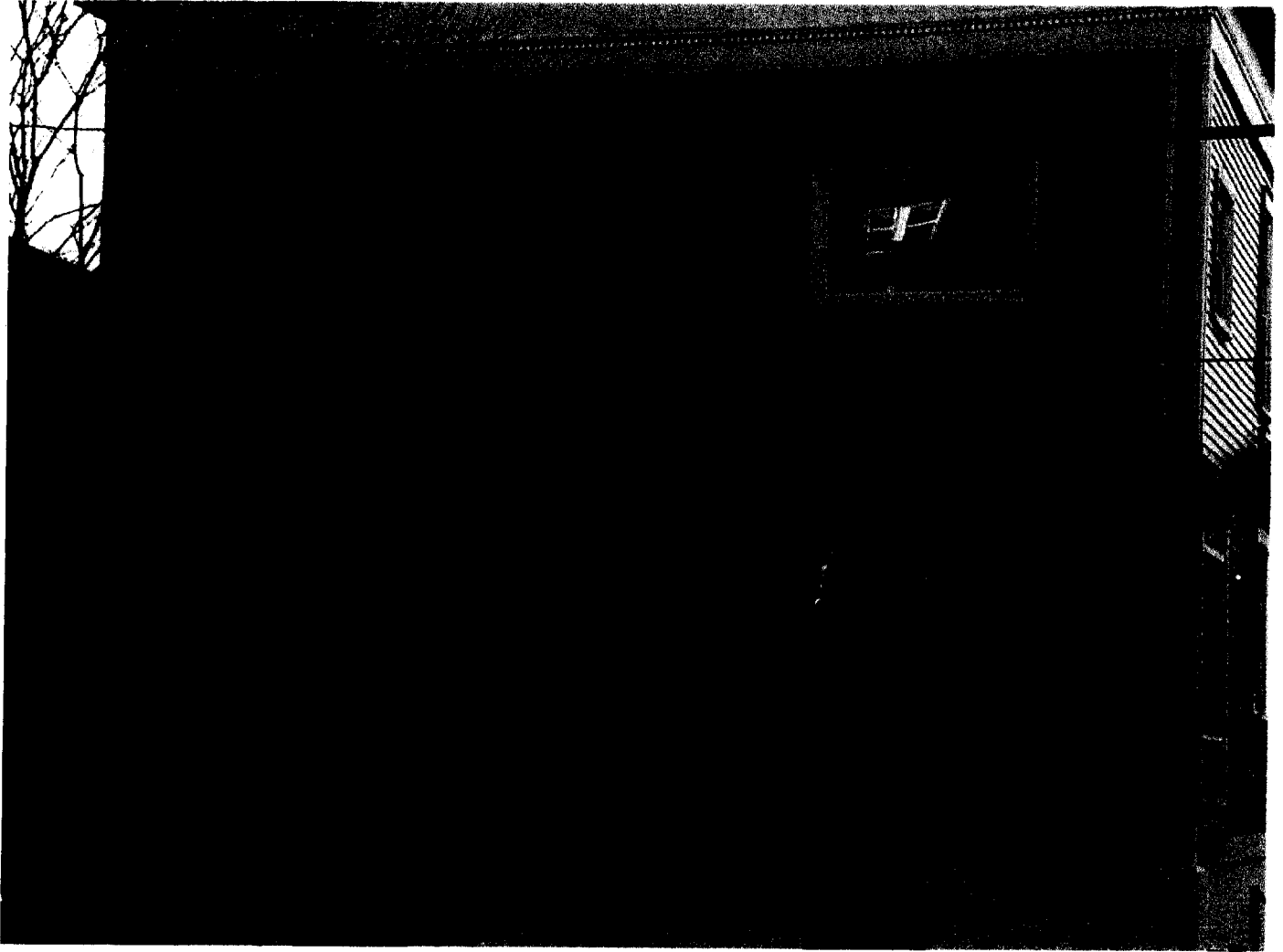

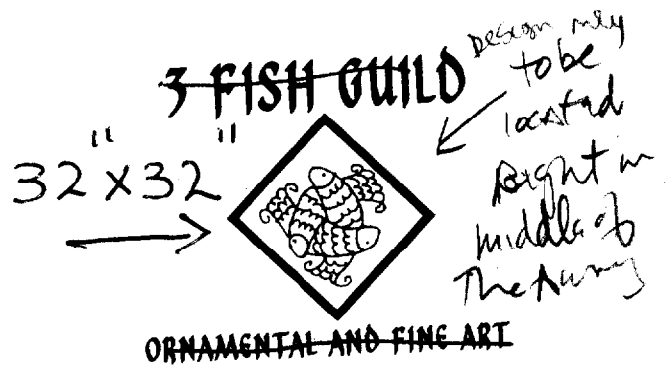
