Thanks for calling back and working through the plumbing fixture issue.

As we discussed, please see the attached revision #1 with the code analysis from the title page of the drawings. I've added notes to reflect our conversation, and changed the occupant load.

Regarding your note on section 1017, exit access travel distance, I checked the table 1017.2 (with sprinklers) and found 300' to be accurate per the analysis. If I've missed something, please let me know.

Regarding your site plan question, the building only has two tenant spaces, and the adjacent unit in the building is vacant.
