Deanna,

Chris forwarded your email regarding the Coastal Pharmacy sign to me, as I'm one of the planners that reviews sign waivers in the B-7 zone. (The B-7 design guidelines specifically prohibit both the use of individual, internally-illuminated plastic letters and box signs, so waivers are required for the sign you've proposed.) Since Chris is away, I am responding.

First, Ann has looked at the plans you provided and has requested more information on overall square footage on the sign that you're now proposing for the Marginal Way frontage. That sign can't exceed 94 SF.

Second, as for the box element which you raised questions about, I have spoken with the city's Urban Designer and others in planning who have been involved in the interpretation of the B-7 design guidelines for signs. As I mentioned above, individual, internally-illuminated letters are technically prohibited, as are box signs. We have made a conscious effort in recent reviews to draw a distinction between box signs (which read as boxes during the daytime, when unlit) and individual letters. We have recently required new sign applicants on Marginal Way to revise these portions of their signs to include a backer panel with individual letters.

Let me know if you have questions on this. We are happy to try to work through solutions with you.

I'm sorry it's taken me a bit to respond.

Ann has asked to see the overall square footage on the sign you're proposing.

Assuming the square footage works, both the individual, internally-illuminated letters and the box element of the sign would need waivers. We have recently required an applicant who proposed a very similar box element on Marginal Way to use a backer panel with individual, internally-illuminated letters.

Good morning Helen,

We have looked in using the Coastal letters and making new channel LED letters (like Coastal) for the "Pharmacy + Wellness". However, those letters are too small to fabrication as channel letters. The stroke of the letters at that size do not allowed enough room to put LED's inside of them. Just so you are aware though, if they were large enough the cost for making that many lighted individual letters would be about \$3,000.

What if we painted the sides and front of the box to match the building color? Only the lettering will light at night and the box would blend into the building during the day making it look like they are individual letters. We wouldn't use the white background shown behind the sign in the last rendering I sent in this case.

We hope to get this resolved soon since they are opening the beginning of December and they need a sign in order to open. I do appreciate the attention you spent on this thus far.

Deanna,

I know and I'm sorry you're disappointed.

The B-7 design guidelines state that "standard internally-illuminated signs - including plastic faced, box-type signs and individual plastic letters - shall be prohibited. Acceptable forms of internal illumination may include halo-lit signs and diecut metal sign panels that illuminate individual letters and symbols only."

Again, we have granted a waiver for the individual letters in the past, so this is just about the box.

Section 14-526 c (8) (a) (iv) Waiver Criteria: An applicant for site plan review that was either denied for failure to comply with the requirements of or is seeking a waiver as part of their site plan application from Section 14-369.5 shall meet the following standards for approval:

- (a) Signs shall meet the requirements of Section 14-526 (e) 2. Signage and Wayfinding;
- (b) The size, scale, proportions, design, materials, placement, quantity and source and intensity of illumination of any approved signage shall be designed to complement and enhance the architectural attributes of the building(s) to which they are attached or to which they are visually related. In addition, such signs shall be appropriate to the scale and character of the neighborhood in which it is located and shall be designed to suit the conditions from which it will be viewed, especially in relation to the distance, travel speed, and mode of travel of the viewing public;
- (c) The signage shall either be of special design merit or shall respond to unique circumstances or characteristics associated with the subject property;
- (d) The provisions of this subsection shall be limited to commercial uses in business or industrial zones, industrial uses or institutional uses.
