Deen,

In my previous e-mails, I described the fact that we had concerns about the internal illumination (which has been addressed). I also expressed concern about the thickness of the cabinet. Now that there is no internal illumination, I'm wondering why the sign needs to be 4 inches thick, or even why it needs to be a cabinet. With this type of sign, the sign panel need only be the thickness of the stock material.

Response: Not clear what the issue is. Becoming concerned about this effort. This is the third design I have presented the city and it sounds like you are looking for a fourth. I don't have the energy to keep presenting options nor am I willing to turn over the design of our sign to the city.. There is nothing in any document you presented to me that limits thickness. I am also not clear how 4" is too thick. If you are not willing to approve this, let's go to whatever the next step is.

Regarding the solar panel, can you tell me where it is proposed to be installed? Also, the specification provided doesn't indicate its dimensions. Is the solar panel proposed because you aren't able to run power to the sign?

Response: The installation for the sign is on the corner of State Street just after the parking lot entrance/exit. We are green oriented and didn't want to tear up the grass and sidewalk to illuminate the sign.

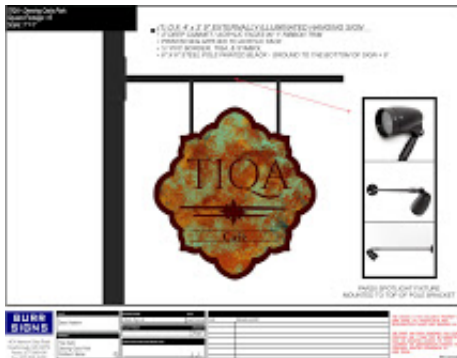
