Dear MAF LLC,

An evaluation of the above-referenced property on 11/15/2017 shows that the structure fails to comply with Chapter 10 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Portland, Fire Prevention and Protection. Attached is a list of the violations.

This is a notice of violation pursuant to Section 6-118 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within 30 days of the date of this notice. A re-inspection of the premises must be scheduled on or before 12/18/2017 at which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code.

This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 6-127 of the Code.

Please be advised that the Portland City Council has amended the Building regulations to include a \$150.00 re-inspection fee. This violation will automatically cause a re-inspection at no charge. including basements.

Violation: NFPA 101- 7.1.3.2.1 60-MIN FIRE DOOR ASSEMBLIES REQ; THE SEPARATION SHALL HAVE A

MINIMUM 1-HOUR FIRE RESISTANCE RATING WHERE THE EXIT CONNECTS THREE OR

FEWER STORIES.
