

With the issuance of this permit, the owner, builder or their designee is required to provide adequate notice to the City of Portland Inspections Division for the inspections listed below. Appointments must be requested 48 to 72 hours in advance. The inspection date will need to be confirmed by this office.

- Please read the conditions of approval that are attached to this permit.
- Permits expire in 6 months if the project is not started or ceases for 6 months.
- If the inspection requirements below are not followed, then additional fees may be incurred due to the issuance of a "Stop Work Order" and subsequent release to continue.
- Per Section 107.3.1 of the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code (MUBEC), one set of printed approved stamped construction documents will be kept at the site of work and open to inspection by building officials.

The Class K fire extinguisher and proper signage should be located at the suppression system pull station.							
 A separate Non-Water Based Suppression System permit is required. This review does not include approval of the suppression system design or installation.

4)	 Installation shall comply with City Code Chapter 10 and NFPA 96, Standard for ventilation Control and Fire Protection of Commercial Cooking Operations, 2008 edition. A signed letter of certification is required.
