Below are my preliminary comments on the materials submitted to date on the site plan and accompanying materials related to bicycle, pedestrian, streetscape and accessibility topics:

- the city arborist should weigh in the adequacy of the existing tree wells within the sidewalk they do not meet current dimensional requirements (typically 4'x7') but should be sized appropriately, if
- adjusted, to maintain the address of the closure where where
- 24*. Sufficient clearance from the exterior gas service and bollards also need to be considered. It appears the bike racks would also block access to the external stairway from the 2nd floor without going onto the adjacent property. Other locations on-site or within the sidewalk on either Forest and/or Cumberland Avenue can also be considered to make them more functional and not block this acces
- the ADA-compliance of the sidewalk and driveway along the project's frontage on Forest Avenue should be confirmed for cross-slope (maximum 2% cross-slope for a minimum of 5' of width) and condition.
