Dear Zoning Administrator,

I am writing to request permission from the city of Portland to allow use of my home at 30 Mechanic Street Apt #2 for a home occupation. I have been running a home daycare on the first floor unit of the same building for 2 years and I am moving to the second floor unit. I will be taking care of no more than three children at one time in addition to my own daughter. In effect my work will be a Licensed family daycare, an acceptable home occupation listed under item (b.)18. of Section 14-410 of the Portland

Zoning Ordinance. The following is an explanation of how my home occupation meets the criteria listed under item (a.) of the same.

- 1. My home occupation will occupy approximately 998 square feet on the second floor of the residence (63%) of the floor area of the residence. 586sf on the third floor will not be used for the home occupation.
- 2. There will be no outside storage of goods and materials nor shall there be exterior displays, or display of goods visible from the outside
- 3. Storage of the material necessary to perform my occupation are minimal and included in the 998 square feet of floor space mentioned above
- 4. There will be no external signage related to my home occupation
- 5. No exterior alterations to the residence are necessary
- 6. Parents will briefly drop off and pick up their children. so on-street parking is adequate
- 7. No objectionable effects will result from my home occupation
- 8. I will not require the services of any employees

- 9. Since I will not be meeting clients at my residence, no additional traffic will be generated by my home occupation
- 10. No vehicles even nearing a gross vehicle weight of 6,000 pounds are necessary for my home occupation

As you can see, my home occupation is a secondary and incidental use of my residence. The external activity level and impact is negligible and in keeping with the residential character of the neighborhood.

Attached you will find a copy of a floor plans showing my entire dwelling and area of the home occupation space, as well as a letter from the owner of the building granting permission to conduct a home occupation on the premises. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.
