Enclosed you will find an application for a sign permit for the space at 561 Congress Street, rented by the Salt Institute for Documentary Studies.

Enclosed is the completed application, proof of insurance coverage, a letter of approval for the design from our building landlord, schematics from our architect on the lot/space, and information from our design company regarding the sign itself.

The "salt" sign will be no higher than 18" and no wider than 50". The letters will sit on top of the existing "awning" and will not protrude in any way. The sign will be applied with lag bolts and metal tabs attached to the base of each letter. The entire sign will weigh approximately 100lbs or less, with lighting by Eco-Light, a Super Nova LED model.

Over the picture window will sit a tag line that reads: "EDUCATING + PROMOTING DOCUMENTARY STORYTELLERS-" each letter being 4.5 inches high x 4 inches wide. The letters will be applied by screwing a 2" hole into the exterior wall and adhering with 3M5200 marine adhesive, each letter will weigh approximately 1.5 pounds.


The building exterior is granite, covered by an exterior façade material called, petrarch.



Hi Donna,

The pin letter tag line will be applied by screwing a 2" hole into the wall and adhering with 3M5200 marine adhesive. Material is salvaged ferrous steel plate. Each letter weighs approximately 1.5 lbs.

The SALT sign will be applied with lag bolts and metal tabs attached to the base of each letter. The entire sign will weigh in at approximately 100 lbs or less. Same material as pin letters.

Lighting is a product called Eco-Light described as Super Nova LED modules.

the weight of the "salt," how it will be affixed, the letters above the window and how they will be affixed, lighting etc etc.




