4. Existing fire protection: the building is fully sprinkled and has a fire alarm system in place. There is also a fire escape that services the second and third floors.

<u>Proposed fire protection</u>: in accordance with the attached analysis by Mark Cummings of Fire Risk management. the life safety systems will be upgraded and include:

- a. upgrading the fire alarm system to meet the code requirements, adding horns and strobes, replacing the existing horn/strobes and installing a new code compliant panel
- b. installing automatic door closers on any door opening in the corridor
- c. permanently closing any transom windows above the doors
- d. replacing any sprinkler head that are older than 50 years old
- e. install exit signs and emergency lights where needed
