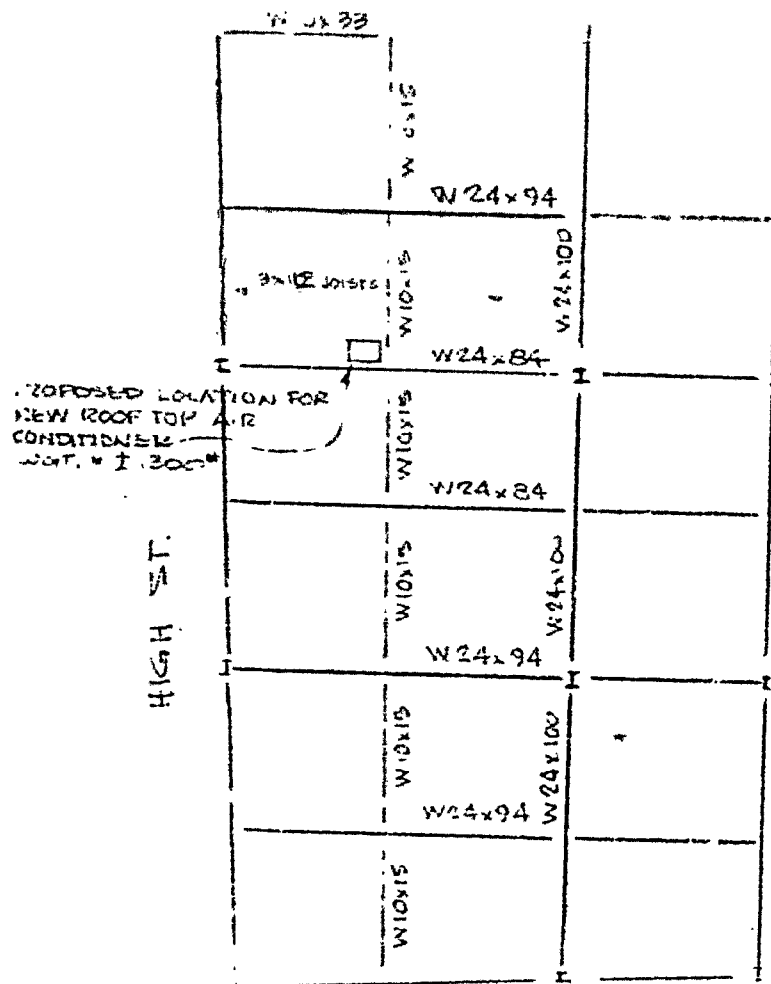

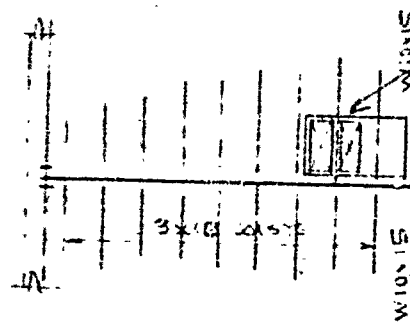

ROOF FRAMING FOR A/C CONDITIONER

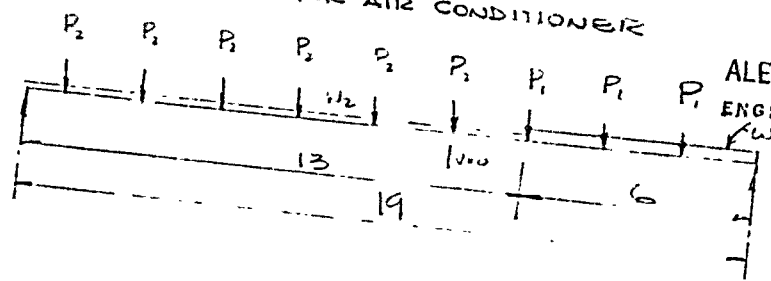
