I have recently received the stamped/engineered electrical drawings, stamped by Harold Thomas, from Mancini Electric for the Internet Hotel @ 340 Cumberland Avenue.

The drawings have been reviewed by myself and have met with my approval. The drawings do not reflect the existing 600amp, 3 phase 120-208volt service. Only one service is allowed to serve this building. The existing service is hereby condemned due to its unsafe condition.

Therefore the existing service shall de-energized and eliminated, in order to facilitate the installation of the new 3000amp, 3 phase 277-480 volt service, pursuant to the following articles of the 1999 NEC.
