

Dear Mr. D'Abate:

On May 16, 2007, the City of Portland's Historic Preservation Board voted 4-0 (Geyer, Pitman & Romano absent) to approve your application for a Certificate of Appropriateness for the construction of a new library addition and the rehabilitation of the Longfellow Garden, including the reconstruction of the garden wall and replication of 1906 Children's Gate.

Board approval was made subject to the following conditions:

- * Exterior lighting plan and specifications to be submitted to staff for review and approval, with the understanding that staff may elect to forward it to the Board for full review.
- * Details and wall sections for Childrens' Gate to be submitted to staff for review and approval.
- * Final planting plan to be reviewed and approved by historic landscape consultant, Lauren Meier. Final plan to be submitted for inclusion in project file.

Note: During final deliberations, the Board and project consultants discussed material options for the garden steps. Although the submitted plans call for brick steps, the Historic Preservation Board supports the use of granite as an appropriate alternative.

<u>All improvements shall be carried out as shown on the plans and specifications submitted for the 5/16/07</u> <u>public hearing and/or as described above</u>. Changes to the approved plans and specifications and any additional work that may be undertaken must be reviewed and approved by this office prior to construction, alteration, or demolition. If, during the course of completing the approved work, conditions are encountered which prevent completing the approved work, or which require additional or alternative work, you must apply for and receive a Certificate of Appropriateness or Non-Applicability PRIOR to undertaking additional or alternative work.

This Certificate is granted upon condition that the work authorized herein is commenced within twelve (12) months after the date is issuance. If the work authorized by this Certificate is not commenced within twelve (12) months after the date of issuance or if such work is suspended in significant part for a period of

one year after the time the work is commenced, such Certificate shall expire and be of no further effect; provided that, for cause, one or more extensions of time for periods not exceeding ninety (90) days each may be allowed in writing by the Department.

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
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
