Gentlemen:

Permit to remodel portion of first floor and basement bordering Congress, Oak and Free St. and 138 seat restaurant, certain interior renovations are issued herewith subject to Portland's International Building Code requirements.

The Planning Board has approved this change of use in the Mainway area provided the sign construction complies with specifications shown on drawing A-6.

The fire department requires emergency lighting (w: cell only).

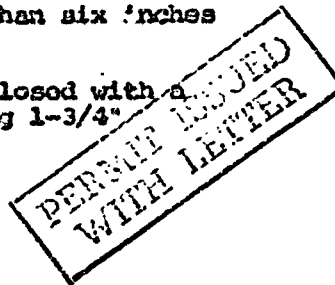
They also require automatic extinguisher system over the fryers and portable extinguishers for the kitchen area and dining area.

While kitchen is required to be enclosed with one-hour fire resistant material, we recognize that due to an operation such as yours it would work a hardship, so we are asking for an "opening protective" consisting of a deluge sprinkler system directly over the serving counter to compensate for the lack of an enclosure.

Anti-panic hardware is required on all doors involved in a means of egress.

Exit signs are to be lighted using letters no less than six inches high on an appropriate background.

The trash room in the basement is required to be enclosed with a one-hour fire resistant partition with a self closing 1-3/4" solid wood core fire door.

Please also be advised that all interior furnishings on the walls and ceilings are required to be fire resistant materials subject to approval of both the fire department and the department of building inspection.

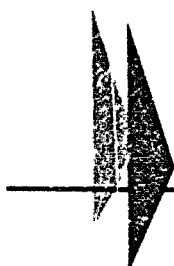

Separate permits will be requested for mechanical work, exterior signs and health department approvals.

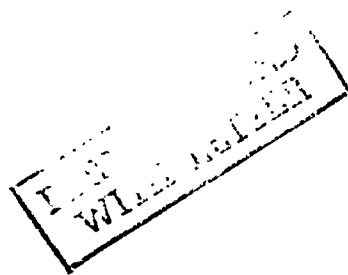
