Gentlemen:

Check of plans and specifications filed with application for enlarging the computer area on the third floor at the above location discloses questions as to compliance with building code requirements as listed below:

1. According to our records this existing area of the third floor has been designed for 200 L.S.F. The new elevated access floor has been designed for 250 L.S.F. with a concentrated load of 1000 pounds on a 1-inch square pad. Details of the elevated floor system indicate the bearing plates to be located at the existing third floor line. Our records further show 1" of perlite topping over the wood and plank sub floors.

Details will be needed to show how the framing is to support the additional loads as mentioned in your construction specifications section 8-b-1.

2. A statement of design signed by a qualified person willing to assume responsibility for the structural design of the floor systems will need to be furnished to be affixed to the plans. Enclosed is a design statement blank for this purpose.

With this information at hand we may further process your application.

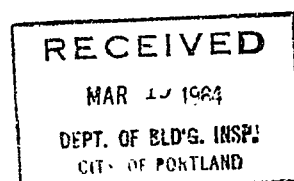

In regard to your inquiry concerning certain alterations proposed in second story of the Baxter Building, it appears that, in view of certain changes in the Building Code since the major alterations to the building were made and because the final layout in this story affords direct access from all office suites to one or more corridors extending between front and rear means of egress, it will be permissible to provide new openings in the walls of the enclosed central hallway provided frames and doors in such openings are of metal and that wire glass is used in any glazed portions. Application for a permit will need to be filed for any such alterations, together with plans showing the proposed layout and details of construction of any new partitions.

It was noted at time of recent inspection that sprinkler heads in this story were not adjusted to provide proper coverage when new corridor and office partitions were erected, thus leaving one portion of new corridor without sprinkler coverage. It is necessary whether or not any new alterations are made, that adjustment of the sprinkler system be made to accommodate the present partition arrangement in all parts of the second story.
