

# Application + Narrative: OVERVIEW

Maine College of Art (522 Congress Street) is seeking to refresh the Free Street entrance with a facelift so it is more aesthetically in keeping with the Congress St. entrance. With the help of local GC, Rich Exterior Solutions, we have investigated options to treat the surface and propose the following next steps:

- Refacing the surface above the glass windows (50' 8" wide x 57  $\frac{7}{8}$ " tall) with a flat metal or 1" thick PVC board
  - Install new surface on-top of what is currently there
  - Same dark grey as on the recently updated Congress St. marquee
  - $\frac{1}{2}$ " protrusion around the frame
  - Flash accordingly so it is one continuous surface
- Affixing the new MECA logo directly above entrance (appx. 4' tall M - E - C - A letters with 'Maine College of Art' to scale below - almost identical to Congress St. entrance, however cut letters will be affixed to the actual surface by using snap pins
- Installing identical lighting solution (Tokistar, supplied by TRS lighting in Falmouth) that is currently installed on the Congress St. marquee (see slide # XX)
