Dear Mr. Cheplic,

This letter is just a follow up to the telephone conversation that we had today. Your store at 494 Congress Street is located in the B-3 zone. According to Section 14-369.5, Table 2.8 of the ordinance, in a multi-tenant building, a ground floor tenant is allowed one building sign. You applied for and were issued a permit (#06-1279) for the US Cellar sign over the door. You also put a banner up under the permitted sign without a permit, and the ordinance does not allow a second sign in that zone. You have fourteen days from the date of this letter to remove the banner.
