
Dear Sir:

Your application to make interior renovations has been reviewed and a permit is herewith issued subject to the following requirements: This permit does not excuse the applicant from meeting applicable State and Federal laws.

1. The State Fire Marshal's approval is required for the sprinkler system renovations.
2. The fire alarm system shall be maintained to NFPA #72 standards.
3. All exit signs, lights, and means of egress lighting shall be done in accordance with Chapter 10, section 4 and subsections 1023. & 1024. of the City's building code. (The BOCA National Building Code/1993)
4. If any fire rated wall or structural elements are penetrated, repairs must be made in such a manner as to obtain the required rating.
5. Cables and wires without combustible jackets or insulation, and non-combustible pipes, tubes, conduits and vents which penetrate a firewall, shall be tested in accordance with ASTM E 119 as part of a rated assembly or shall be protected by an approved through-penetration protection system that has been tested in accordance with ASTM E 814.
6. Firestopping and draftstopping shall be done in accordance with Chapter 7 section 720.0 of the City's building code.
7. All interior finish shall be installed and meet the requirements of chapter 8 of the City's building code.
