
This letter is to certify the designer qualifications for the above referenced project, to meet the requirements of the City of Portland, Maine Fire Alarm Permit application.

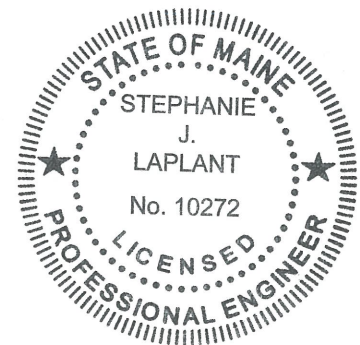
