- 1. This permit is being approved on the basis of plans submitted. Any deviations shall require a separate approval before starting that work.
- This property shall remain a retail and artist studio workshop on the 1st floor with architect's offices remaining on the 2nd floor with the issuance of this permit and subsequent issuance of a certificate of occupancy. Any change of use shall require a separate permit application for review and approval.

Fire

- 1. All construction shall comply with City Code Chapter 10. The occupancy shall comply with City Code Chapter 10 upon inspection.
