you shouldn't need any permits from the city.. as long as this is just a one-day event.... and you are not using any city property for the event...


the only thing i think you have to do is obviously get permission from the buildings owners...




The image to be projected on the museum will be as you see it above with a red background with white letters. The letters will be about 23' x 23' and the red would be 30' x 50'




