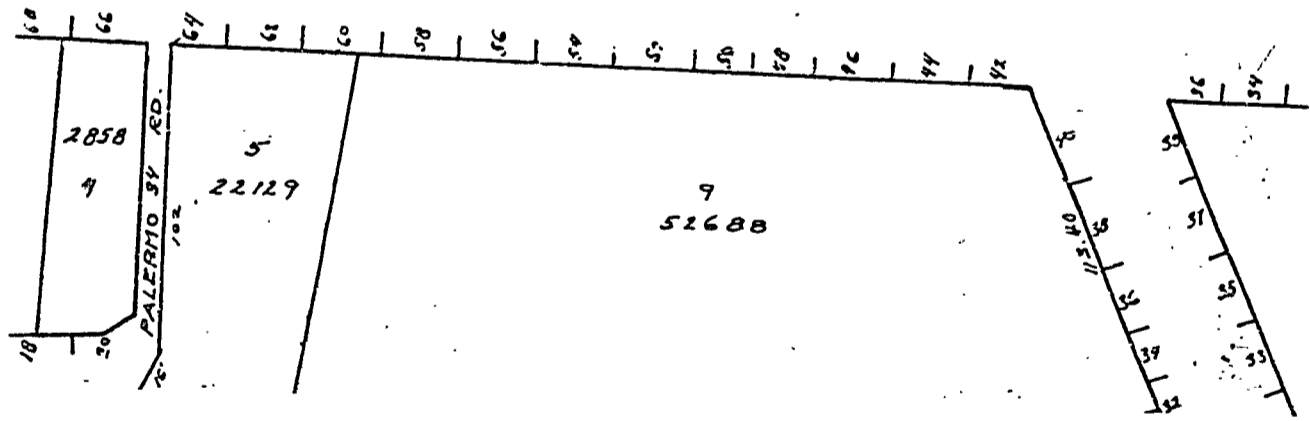
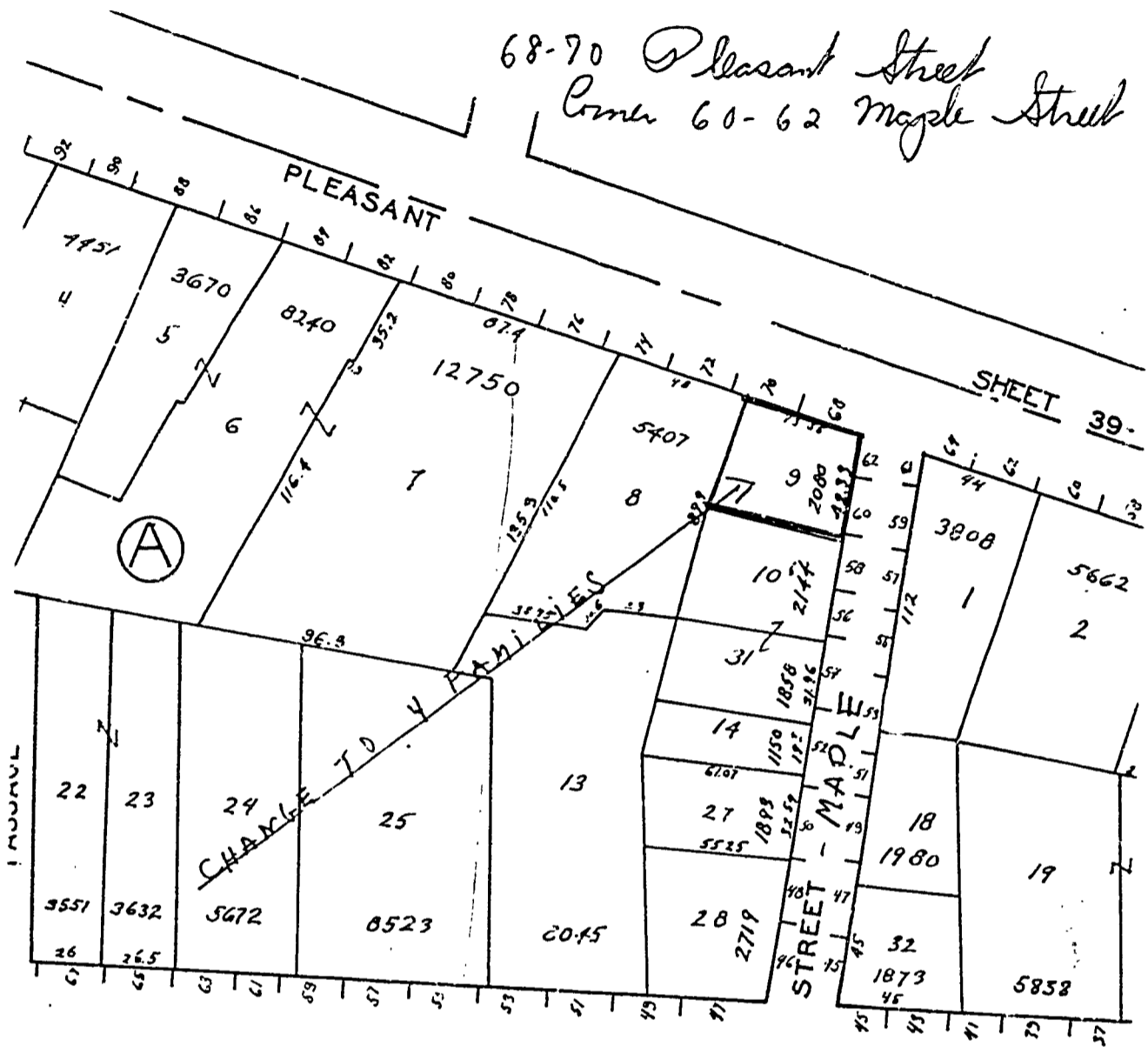

Your application to change 68 Pleasant Street from a 3 family unit to a 4 family unit as appealed and sustained on July 21, 1982 by the Portland Board of Appeal is being issued with the following requirements.


1. All doors involved in the means of egress shall be equipped with latch sets which shall open from the inside without the use of keys, special knowledge, or ability, but by merely turning the usual knob or by pressure on a plate or lever.
2. The boiler room shall be enclosed with construction having a fire rating of at least one hour, including the ceiling, and fire doors with self-closers.
3. Each apartment shall be equipped with a single station smoke detector wired to the house current. These detectors shall be placed in a manner which will protect the sleeping areas.
4. Each apartment shall have a one hour separation from the adjoining apartments and corridors.
5. All exit doors shall be 1 hour rated with self closers.
6. All windows within 15 feet horizontal or vertical of the exit access porches shall be protected with fixed $\frac{1}{2}$ " wired glass in steel sashes.
7. The new smoke detector ordinance requires all apartment units to have installed a single station (self contained) approved (UL or FM) smoke detector. The detectors shall be placed in a location which will protect the sleeping area.
8. Windows and exterior doors may be used as natural means of light and ventilation and when so used, their aggregate glass area shall amount to not less than 8 percent of the floor area served, and with not less than one half of the required area available for unobstructed ventilation.
9. If mechanical ventilation is the required, it is to be 50 Fm³ per human occupant. Mechanical ventilation for bathrooms is one change of air every 12 minutes.

10. Walls, partitions and floor/ceiling assemblies separating dwelling units for each other or other public or service areas shall have a sound transmission class (STC) of not less than 45 for airborne noise when tested in accordance with ASTM90. This requirement shall not apply to dwelling unit entrance doors, but such doors shall be tight fitting to the frame and sill.
