WE ARE REQUESTING A PERMIT TO ALLOW USE OF OUR RESIDENCE FOR HOME OCCUPATION. MY WIFE INTENDS TO OPERATE A HAIR SALON, AN ACCEPTABLE HOME OCCUPATION LISTED UNDER SECTION 14-410 OF THE PORTLAND ZONING ORDINANCE

1. THE HOME OCCUPATION WILL OCCUPY APPROXIMATELY 400 SQ FT
2. THERE WILL BE NO OUTSIDE STORAGE OF GOODS; NOR SHALL THERE BE A DISPLAY OF GOODS WHICH WOULD BE VISIBLE FROM THE OUTSIDE
3. STORAGE OF MATERIALS RELATED TO THE HOME OCCUPATION WILL BE CONFINED TO THE HAIR SALON ITSELF
4. EXTERIOR SIGNS WILL BE LIMITED AS PER SEC 14-410
5. THERE WILL BE NO ALTERATIONS TO THE EXTERIOR OF THE BUILDING THAT AFFECTS THE RESIDENTIAL APPEARANCE.
6. WE HAVE OFF STREET PARKING AVAILABLE NEXT TO OUR RESIDENCE
7. THERE WILL BE NO OFFENSIVE ODORS, NOISE OR SMOKE GENERATED BY THE HOME OCCUPATION
8. THERE WILL BE NO INCREASE IN THE TRAFFIC OF THE AREA DUE TO THE HOME OCCUPATION

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
