HVAC / Power Equipment Checklist

All of the following information is required and must be submitted. Checking off each item as you prepare your application package will ensure your package is complete and will help to expedite the permitting process.

\checkmark	A floor plan that includes structural details, size and dimensions of the floor the equipment is going to be installed.
\checkmark	Information on how the unit is being vented & hanging details if appropriate.
\checkmark	Details of the specific equipment being installed; ie; specifications and any heating technical specifications. Often this information can be obtained from the manufacturer's spec sheet or retail advertisements.
\checkmark	A plot plan showing the shape and dimension of the lot, with the distance from the actual property lines, and the principal structure may be required.
	Proof of ownership is required if it is inconsistent with the assessors records.

All HVAC installations must be conducted in compliance with the IRC 2009 Building Code

Separate permits are required for plumbing and electrical installations, as required.

Separate permits are also required based on different properties (different Chart, Block and Lot.)

Permit Fee: \$30.00 for the first \$1000.00 construction cost, \$10.00 per additional \$1000.00 cost

This is not a Permit; you may not commence any work until the Permit is issued.
