We regret to inform you that your recent request for street opening permit and street occupancy permit waivers have been denied. After reviewing your request, we have determined that it would not be possible to accommodate your request.

We have reviewed your letter and the approval letter issued January 28, 2013 by the Planning Board as well as a comparison of other developments of comparable size and find it does not warrant waving any street opening permits or all of the street occupancy permits

The breakdown of street occupancy permits is \$15.00 a day for every 20 linear feet of parking. This section of Commercial Street has 60 degree parking and was calculated to have eight (8) spaces. Maple Street is calculated for 10 parking spaces. In addition to street occupancy permits, we charge \$15.00 a day for each sidewalk closure. A separate permit is required for street openings as well as sewer connection and storm drain connection. For more information, you may contact our street opening clerk at (207) 874-8822.
