Hi Justin, great news; per our conversation today, this email is to confirm that your exterior sign has been approved, as follows:

It is mounted on a black steel sleeve that slides over the bollard closest to Commercial Street, along the brick sidewalk & the bracket on top of the sleeve is no lower than 8' from the ground.

No electric lighting or sign mounted lighting will be approved at this time; we will look for some other methods (ex: tasteful small solar from landscaping or an alternate location or direction) for future use, provided they will meet the City lighting restrictions & guidelines for a restaurant.

A 1' high x 4' wide wooden sign will be mounted in the bracket on top of the steel sleeve. It will be of appropriate construction & materials to maintain a professional appearance at all times. It may have gold leaf, gold metal or gold painted lettering as proposed (King's Head with arrow) & it may have a tag line, as proposed (ex: Great Food-Craft Beer or similar), in smaller lettering.

The sign must be approved & permitted in writing by the City, in advance.

We will allow continued use of the sandwich board sign along Commercial Street until the new sign is installed or 12/1/14, which ever comes first. We will look for some alternate locations for the daily placement of the sandwich sign, as discussed today, provided it remains well maintained & does not restrict traffic flow.
