## Second Notice of Violation- Billing Notification

## Dear Mary K. Cordona:

An evaluation of the above-referenced property on September 23, 2008 revealed that the structure is non-compliant with the Housing Code of the City of Portland.

A walkthrough inspection and confirmation from the Portland Water District revealed that the water was shut off at the property. The property was posted-against-occupancy on September 23, 2008; in order to re-occupy the structure you were instructed to submit an action plan to correct all housing violations identified during the inspection.

## These violations require correction. They are as follows:

- 1. The structure must comply with **§ 6-109.5 Standards for unoccupied residential structures**. of our Housing Code. This shall include keeping the building: free from vermin infestation, weather proof, watertight, and structurally sound, and secured from vandals.
- 2. In order to re-occupy the structure an after the fact building permit must be submitted for demolition work, and or repairs made to interior portions of the building.

This is a second notice of violation pursuant to § 6-118 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected. A re-evaluation will occur within fourteen (14) days of this notice, at which time compliance will be required. Moreover, the City Council has amended the Building regulations to include a \$75.00 re-inspection fee.
