Notification must be made no less than 14 days before the Harbor Commission's next Public Hearing. Public Hearings are held on the second Thursday of each month.

The Harbor Commission strongly recommends that notification be made via certified mail (return receipt requested) or hand-delivered personally. Failure to make proper notification of all abutters, lessees, and other users will invalidate your permit.

- 13. If this application is approved and a permit is issued:
  - a. The permit must be posted at the construction site.
- b. The permit will require that the construction project be surrounded by a containment boom unless the requirement has been waived, in writing, by the Harbor Commission.

Pursuant to Title 12 M.R.S.A., Section 1801 & 1862, the Bureau of Parks and Lands serves as trustee of submerged lands for the State of Maine. Submerged lands include all land from the mean **low-water** mark seaward to the 3-mile territorial limit including all land below the mean **low-water** mark of tidal rivers upstream to the farthest natural reaches of the tides. Constructive easements were granted for 30 years to structures located on submerged lands in 1975. The Bureau has received an application to obtain a new 30-year lease or easement for the existing structure described above.

A lease or easement may be granted if the structure does not:

☑ unreasonably interfere with customary or traditional public access ways to, or public trust rights (fishing, fowling, recreation, and navigation) in, on or over the submerged lands;

III unreasonably interfere with fishing or other existing marine uses of the area;

☑ unreasonably diminish the availability of services and facilities necessary for commercial marine activities; and

interfere with ingress and egress of riparian owners.

While reviewing the application, the Bureau will take into account the fact that the structure has been in place for 30 years or more, and that some portion(s) may not comply with the current Submerged Lands Rules. As part of the Bureau's review, it will consider whether any non-permanent elements of a structure, such as floats, should be adjusted to improve the distance between structures. A copy of the site plan is attached for information. Any interested party or anyone who is knowledgeable about the area is welcome to comment on possible impacts to the activities listed above. Written comments must be received by the Bureau on or before February 4, 2006.

The Bureau's records indicate that the above structures have been in place since 1975 and therefore were granted "constructive easements" to occupy submerged lands for 30 years. These easements expired on October 1, 2005 and the owners have applied for a new conveyance (lease or easement) to maintain their existing structure on public submerged lands. No changes to the structures are proposed.

The purpose of this letter is to provide the municipality with an opportunity to comment on any significant impacts the structure may have as described on the enclosed Notice. We also ask that the municipality notify us if any of the existing structures are not in compliance with local permitting requirements such as expansions without prior permit approval. Please post the enclosed Notices in the municipal office. The comment period will be 30 days, unless we receive a request for an extension.

Comments from the municipal officials and/or harbormaster, will greatly assist the Bureau in determining whether there is an opportunity to improve an existing condition before a new 30-year conveyance is granted. If significant concerns are raised regarding public trust rights, or it appears that setback distances can be improved, the Bureau will try to work with the owner to lessen these impacts by modifying any non-permanent elements of a structure. Generally, the Bureau will not request that permanent structures be modified.
