These include all OSHA, NIOSH, U.S. EPA, local ordinance and any other applicable governmental regulations. The General Contractor will remain responsible for safeguarding the general public.

The General Contractor is advised to visit the site to confirm the site conditions. The site was demolished in the Spring of 2016 which cleared the two dwellings, walkways, and other developed areas. However, some construction debris remains on site as well as multiple trees, stone walls, and a fence line. It is the sole responsibility of the contractor to demolish the rest of the site in full compliance with City and State regulations.
