NOTICE OF INTENT TO PROSECUTE

Dear Russell Lamour:

An evaluation of the above-referenced property on the 27th day of March, 2008 revealed that the structure fails to comply with previous violation notices sent to you.

Attached is a list of those violations cited on your first and second notice of violation.

The property continues to be in violation of Article V. of the Housing Code of the City of Portland. Furthermore, building permit # 070518 expired; a new permit application must be submitted prior to the start of any construction work. A re-evaluation of the premises will occur on the 23rd day of May, 2008 at which time a building permit application must be accepted by this office. Once the new building permit is issued all required work must be complete within thirty (30) days.

This is a notice of intent to prosecute. The matter is being referred to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in § 115 of the Code, and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. ss 4452.

Please be advised that because this is a letter of intent to prosecute, and that § 6.2 of the Code requires that you pay a \$75.00 re-inspection fee due to the repeated violations. Failure to pay the assessed fee within thirty (30) days shall cause the City to assess a lien against the property pursuant to § 1-16 of the Code.
