NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Robert & Donna Wadsworth,

An evaluation of your property at 17 Tate Street on February 5, 1998 at 9:50 a.m. revealed that the structure built on the right side of the house fails to comply with Chapter 6 Article II of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Portland, The BOCA National Building Code.

Attached is a list of the violations and copies of the referenced Code sections.

This is a notice of violation pursuant to Section 107.1 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within 30 days of the date of this notice. A reinspection of the premises will occur on March 10, 1998 at which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code.
