west corner of John Hasty's Lode between Northwestly on
York street twenty-four feet or more eighteen inches of the western side of the brick
wall of my brick store & dwelling house twice turning about angles and running Northwestly parallel with
Brackett street seventy feet, thence Southwesterly nine feet six inches or more sixteen feet of said Jordan's South-
west line as hereafter designated, thence Northwestly twenty-eight feet, thence Southwesterly sixteen feet, thence
Southeasterly nine feet to the bounds begun at Reserving to me the said Elihu Hasty my heirs and assigns
the right to use a passage way of four feet six inches in width from York street Northwestly eighty feet
on the easterly side of the dwelling house herein conveyed to said Jordan in common with said Jordan
