This letter is to inform you that we will soon be demolishing the structures at 22 Tate St.

The removal of the main building and shed at 22 Tate Street will pave the way for West Port Lofts, an 8 unit condominium project. We hope that you have had the opportunity to participate in the public process to learn more about this project. The project received Site Plan Approval from the City of Portland Planning Board late last year. We are now completing the architectural drawings to obtain a building permit.

We plan to begin construction in May. The first order of business will be the demolition of the existing buildings. We will notify you as soon as we have a firm start date.

Building on such a small site and street presents a challenge. We have chosen a contractor who we believe understands this and will be sensitive to the situation. There will be a preconstruction meeting to give you more information and contacts in case you have concerns.

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
