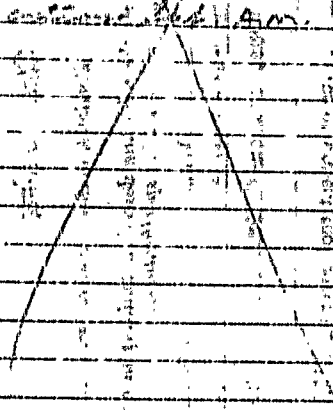

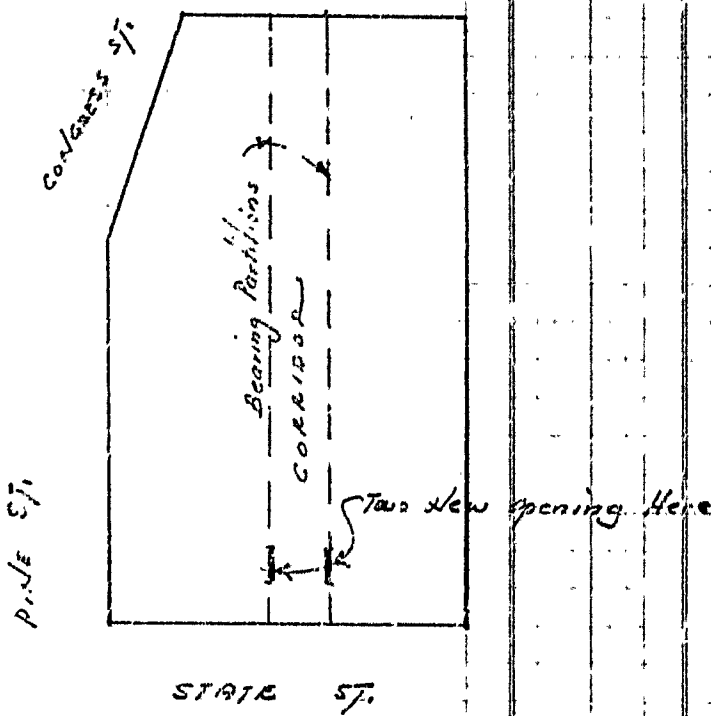

With reference to your File Rept. 887D-1, regarding the 6" x 10" fir girder, the actual clear span of this beam will only be 9'-9", the dimension of 12'-0" shown on plans is the overall size of the fir timber.

We find that the section modulus required for this span is 78 and the section modulus of this dressed 6" x 10" fir timber is 82.7.

Subject: Building permit for repair
after fire at 131 State Street

Gentlemen:

Enclosed is the building permit as above. Please note the following:

It is assumed that there is to be no change in the height of the roofs and no increase in height of the masonry walls, also that the masonry walls are not damaged by fire. I am not sure that I understand from the plans just what the alterations are as indicated on the application for the permit. It is my understanding that wherever the structural steel column show distortion or to be definitely affected by the fire in any way, they are to be replaced by new material. If the skylights are to be new or if necessary to replace them, the work should be done in compliance with Section 313-c of the Building Code. If any of the cornice in substantial sections is to be new or if substantial sections of the old cornice are to be replaced, the work should comply with Section 307-b-5 of the Building Code. If the repairs are only minor in nature, compliance with the Code will not be insisted upon. I note some wall anchors from roof joists to brick walls are shown on the southerly side of the building, but cannot find any indicated on the opposite ends of the joists. If feasible these should be provided.

The 6x10 fire girder shown on a 12-foot span on Section E appears to be deficient. I make the theoretical strength 6900 pounds, the theoretical load even without any ceiling load is 7900. There is no indication of the type of support under either end of this girder, and I assume that the balance of this line of support is bearing partition adequately supported clear down to the ground.

181 State St.-- Installation of Dental Furnace for State Dental Laboratory by Portland Gas Light Co. --2/6/41

To Owner and Installer:

Since this device is indicated to have an input maximum of less than 50,000 BTU per hour, the Code does not require that it be vented. It is understood that the owner is desirous of venting it, and we believe that to be the best arrangement. It is understood that a metal vent pipe is to be run from the appliance through the brick wall of the building without going through any intervening partitions.

Since the appliance is designed to attain inside the furnace a maximum temperature of 2000 F. care must be taken to see that the vent pipe is not close to burnable material. Even if vent pipe is interrupted no temperatures are not more than 530 degrees F. the pipe should not be closer than 6 inches to burnable material at any point. Temperatures inside pipe may be in excess of such figure, 12 inches from burnable material to be maintained, and at least 15 inches lead unless adequate shield is provided.

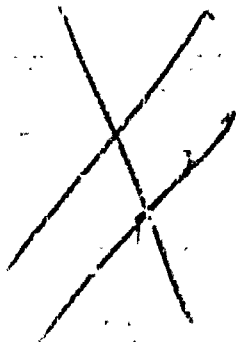

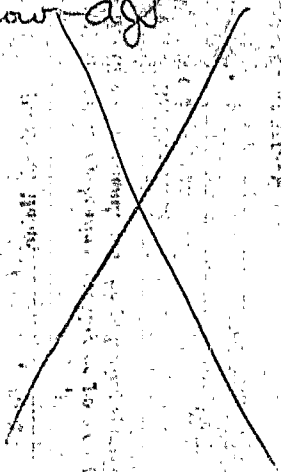

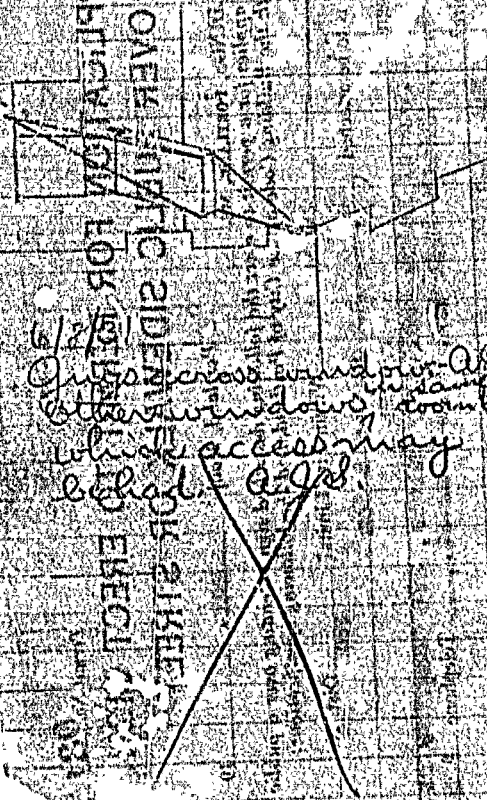
