Zoning

- 1. This permit is being approved on the basis of plans submitted. Any deviations shall require a separate approval before starting that work.
- 2. ANY exterior work requires a separate review and approval thru Historic Preservation. This property is located within an Historic District.
- 3. All previous conditions from the original permit #2012-01-2999 are still in force with the issuance of this permit.

Historic

1. New door and door surround to match existing in all details and specifications.

Fire

- 2. All construction shall comply with City Code Chapter 10.
- 3. The doors in the 2-hour fire rated walls shall be 90-minute rated per 101:8.3.4.
- 4. This permit is being approved on the basis of the plans submitted. Any deviation from the plans would require amendments and approval.
- 5. Any Fire alarm or Sprinkler systems shall be reviewed by a licensed contractor(s) for code compliance. Compliance letters are required.
- 6. A separate Fire Alarm Permit is required for new systems; or for work effecting more than 5 fire alarm devices; or replacement of a fire alarm panel with a different model. This review does not include approval of fire alarm system design or installation.
- 7. A separate Suppression System Permit is required for all new suppression systems or sprinkler work effecting more than 20 heads. This review does not include approval of sprinkler system design or installation.
- 8. Installation of a sprinkler or fire alarm system requires a Knox Box to be installed per city ordinance.
- 9. A firefighter Building Marking Sign is required.
- 10. Fire extinguishers are required per NFPA 1.
- 11. Any cutting and welding done will require a Hot Work Permit from Fire Department.
- 12. Walls in structure are to be labeled according to fire resistance rating. IE; 1 hr. / 2 hr. / smoke proof.
- 13. A single source supplier should be used for all through penetrations.
