I am writing to express **my opposition to the proposed 1 Joy Place condo units** off of our neighborhood on Brackett Street in the West End. I have been living here with my family since 2010 and have steadily witnessed the **overcrowding and parking issues** created by new development in the neighborhood.

I feel that the plan put forth for 1 Joy Place will cause a severe decrease in the already hard to find off street parking situation.

Also, this is not affordable housing for the families in this quiet neighborhood near Reiche School. With more and more high end housing being added to the already over-inflated market, I also fear that the people who work in the downtown area in the service industries will no longer be able to live on the Peninsula as I know many friends who have had to move to Westbrook or South Portland and commute, leading to more parking and traffic issues.
